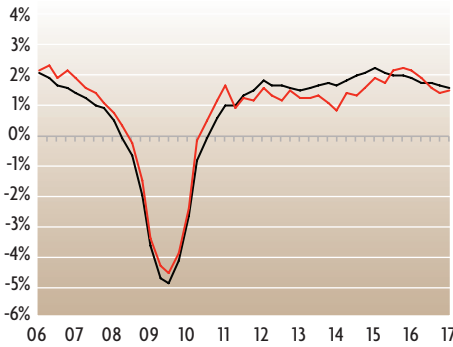

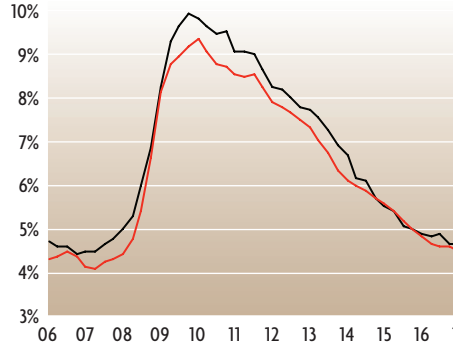

Unemployment Rate

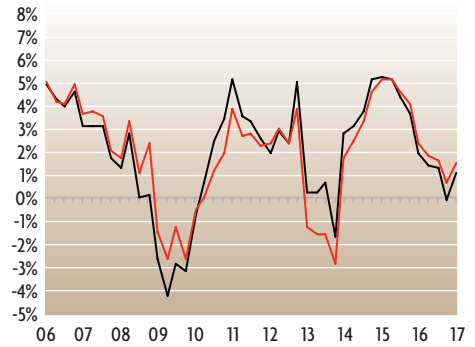
First Quarter 2006 - First Quarter 2017

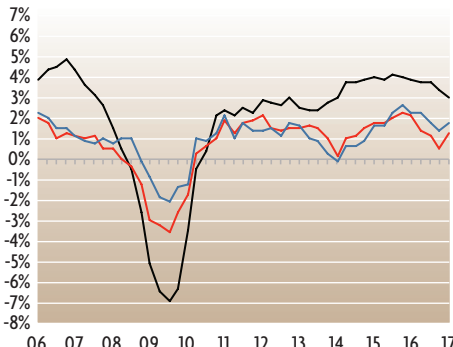

Nonfarm Employment Major Metro Areas

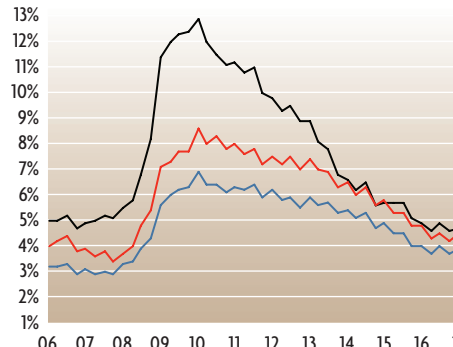

Unemployment Rate Major Metro Areas

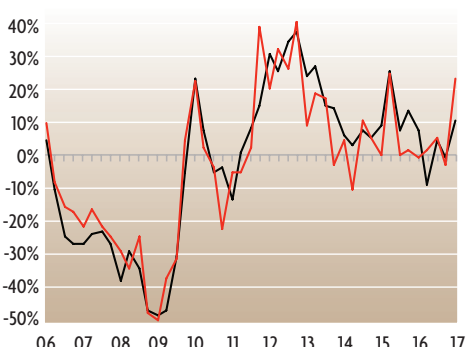

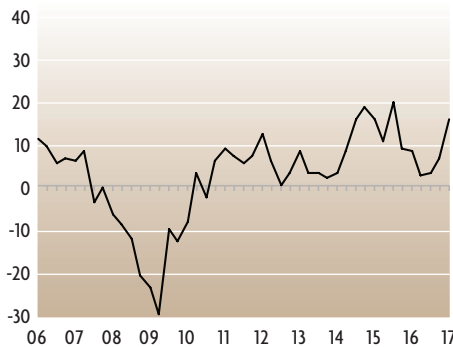

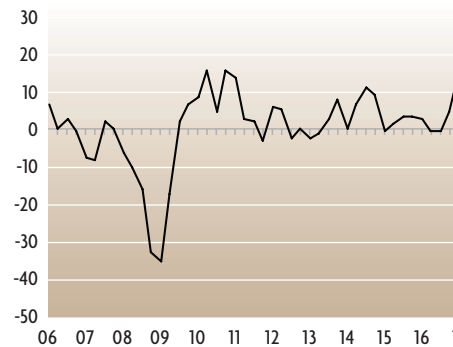
FRB—Richmond Services Revenues Index

FRB—Richmond Manufacturing Composite Index

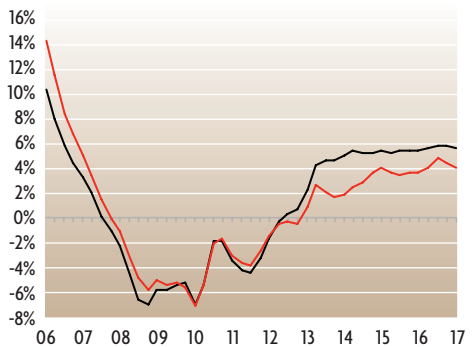
