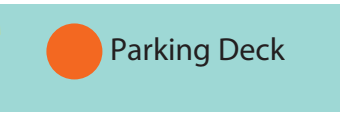

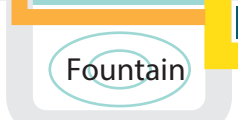

DIRECTIONS TO THE FED EXPERIENCE

From the South

Take I-95 North to Exit 74-A, Downtown Expressway (I-195). Take the Downtown Expressway to the exit for Canal Street. Follow Canal Street to 5th Street. Turn left on 5th Street and continue approximately two blocks. Turn left onto Byrd Street. See the Visitor Parking section.

From the North

Take I-95 South to Exit 75 (64 East). Immediately take the 3rd Street Exit (also Coliseum). Follow 3rd Street to Byrd Street. Turn left on Byrd Street. See the Visitor Parking section.

From the East

Take I-64 West to Exit 190, 5th Street Exit. Follow 5th Street, then turn left onto Byrd Street. See the Visitor Parking section.

From the West

Take I-64 East to Exit 186, Downtown Expressway (I-195). Take the Byrd Street/2nd Street Exit. Follow Byrd Street. The Bank will be on your right between 7th and 9th Street. See the Visitor Parking section.

Visitor Parking

Car, Van or Small Bus Parking

When you arrive, the vehicle will pull into the driveway directly in front of the Bank (right off Byrd Street) and follow the drive into the parking lot. Once parked, you will enter the security pavilion for visitor screening. Bank staff will be positioned to assist you with screening and escorting you to your destination.

School or Charter Bus Parking

When you arrive, the bus will pull into the driveway directly in front of the Bank and unload passengers (see the section in orange on the map). The bus should not attempt to pull into the parking lot because it will not be able to turn around once inside. After the passengers have been unloaded, it will pull back out onto Byrd Street and proceed to Bragg Street where it will park beside the parking deck. Bank staff will be positioned to assist passengers with screening and escorting you to your destination.
