## ALBERT H. DUDLEY

---

**A**LBERT H. DUDLEY was born at Haleford, Franklin County, Virginia, September 22, 1885, but at the age of twelve years moved with his parents to Martinsville, Virginia. He attended the public schools at Haleford and Martinsville and afterwards was a cadet for two terms at the Martinsville Military Academy, and in 1901 entered the Locust Dale Academy, Locust Dale, Virginia, where he was a student for two sessions.

In 1904 Mr. Dudley began his banking career with the Farmers Bank, Martinsville, Virginia, which was converted into the First National Bank of Martinsville in 1905. He left that institution in 1906 to accept a position with the National Exchange Bank, of Roanoke, Virginia, where he was located for twelve years. For five years of that period he was Assistant Cashier, from which position he resigned in December, 1917, to accept an appointment as Assistant Federal Reserve Agent, Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond, Virginia. He served in that capacity until March 1, 1922, when he was appointed Manager of the Baltimore Branch, Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond, Baltimore, Maryland, which position he now occupies.
