FHFA House Price Index: North Carolina








North Carolina


Percent in Foreclosure or REO by Zip Code

Percent Delinquent by Zip Code




North Carolina




by Zip Code**




North Carolina



Percent in Foreclosure or REO by Zip Code

North Carolina


Percent Delinquent by Zip Code

North Carolina






Owner-Occupied Loan Statistics: North Carolina





Owner-Occupied Prime Loan Statistics: North Carolina





Owner-Occupied Subprime Loan Statistics: North Carolina






